SASPEN will be presenting 2 Life Long Learning (LLL) courses at this year's congress namely "Nutrition support in the peri-operative period" and "ICU Nutrition: Treatment and problem solving". Both LLL courses will be presented by our international speakers Prof Remy Meier and Prof Claude Pichard. They will also join us for the congress program.
