Thus far 2020 has been an exceptional year with unprecedented challenges. Like most sectors, including health care, SASPEN and its activities have been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Since the outbreak of this pandemic there have been many publications and webcasts put forward by multiple societies and companies to help guide the nutritional management of this disease and the practical challenges this poses. Based on international guidelines and adjusted to be practically appropriate to the South African environment, SASPEN has produced a set of guidelines for the nutritional management of patients affected by COVID-19. The document, alongside supportive information and practical tools, is available on the SASPEN website.

The yearly congress hosted by The Critical Care Society of Southern Africa (CCSSA) and SASPEN which was scheduled to take place in July 2020 in Johannesburg has unfortunately been cancelled due to COVID-19. We do however look forward to hosting a congress at the same venue in 2021.

This year the SASPEN PM Ward Round Club was planned to be expanded to include the start of a separate branch for the Gauteng region. We continue with the current format of the Cape Town SASPEN PM Ward Round with an option of a live Facebook feed for members residing more than 50 km from Cape Town. The SASPEN PM Ward Round Club is temporarily suspended during the lockdown period. This amount can either be awarded in full to one applicant or can be divided between a number of applicants. Applications must be fully paid-up members of SASPEN. Applications close 31 May 2020.
